Tax authority publishes 2022 audit plan

The Hungarian tax authority has published its new audit plan, with business activities such as online sales, construction, food delivery and the food industry in the focus. The tax authority puts greater emphasis on the use of data from online invoice reporting and from the international information exchange. Taxpayers can expect an uptick in audits related to employment issues (non-reporting of employees, as well as “hidden employment” due to the increasing popularity of the so-called KATA lump sum tax option available primarily for individual entrepreneurs), especially with a view to the tax authority's substance-over-form approach and rights.
